- (b) Using a clear and well-explained illustration demonstrate the impact of the imposition of user charges for medical services/health care on the equilibrium position of a consumer (patient).

- (c) Explain the rationale for the imposition of user fees for medical care in Sub-Saharan Africa. (5 marks)
- (d) Briefly describe any three effects of the imposition of user fees for medical care in your country. (5 marks)

- (a) Describe any three problems which arise when defining and measuring the output of a hospital? (5 marks)
- (b) Suggest practical strategies to solve each of the problems in (a) above? (5 marks)
- (c) Compare the pros and cons of the Stochastic Frontier Approach and Nonparametric Data Envelopment Analysis (DEA) methods of measuring hospital efficiency. (15 marks)

- (a) Using examples what is the meaning of equity in health? (10 marks)
- (b) Describe any five causes of health inequity in your country. (5 marks)
- (c) Suggest any five practical strategies to address the causes of health inequity identified in (b) above. (10 marks)

- (a) Distinguish between Electronic health (E-health) or Telehealth and Telemedicine. (5 marks)
- (b) By means of any five examples, justify the need for the wide use of electronic health and telemedicine in your country. (10 marks)
